## **About the Club**

#### Who will be there?

- This five session fortnightly group program will be facilitated by AuDHDer psychologist Bridie Gray with the help of a provisional psychologist and psychology students.
- There will be approximately 10 members

## What is the purpose of the Club?

- The club was created as Bridie noticed a lack of safe, neuroaffirming places for Autistic girls to make friends.
- The main goal of the club is for Autistic girls to make friends through shared interests
- Another goal is to encourage the members to think about and reflect on topics that impact autistic girls, such as identity, wellbeing, individual needs, appropriate accommodations and self-advocacy.

## What will the group members do?

- Bridie will provide materials to create different art and craft projects each week
- The group members will work on their projects individually - there is no group work nor competition involved
- Bridie will also provide discussion points on topics important for Autistic girls
- Bridie will speak from her own lived experience an encourage the girls to share their ideas and reflections.
